

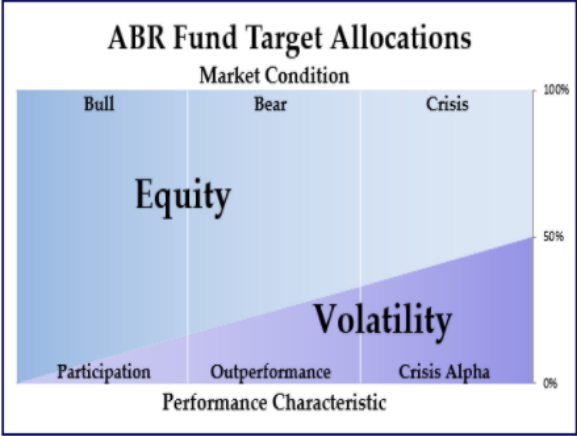
# ABR Dynamic Blend Equity & Volatility Fund

## (Inv - Inst Classes)

### FUND DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES

The ABR Dynamic Blend Equity and Volatility Fund is a sub-fund of MontLake Corrib UCITS Platform ICAV, an Irish collective asset management vehicle constituted as an umbrella fund with segregated liability between sub-funds with registration number C155133. The investment objective of the Fund is to achieve investment returns by investing at least 80% of the NAV in futures listed or traded on one or more recognized markets that provide exposure to US large-cap equity securities including volatility in the US equity markets. The Fund’s performance target characteristics are to generate long-term outperformance with reduced swings and drawdowns, by producing:

- Partial equity participation in a bull market
- Outperformance of equities in a bear market
- Significant positive returns in a crisis



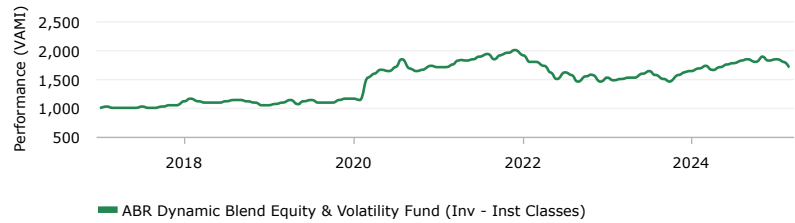

IM COMMENTARY

In March, the S&P 500 dropped 5.63% while volatility climbed a relatively modest 12.56% (SPVIXSTR Index). The ABR Dynamic Blend Equity and Volatility Fund’s model is primarily a volatility trend-following model. During early March, in response to the increase in volatility, the model was active and increased the Fund’s exposure to volatility assets. However, with no follow through on the uptrend in volatility and reversal down lower, there was no opportunity to benefit from the increased allocation. The Fund lost 5.66% for the month, and the model ended the month in a lower volatility exposure.

Mr. Lukof, as a market maker, was responsible for trading single name and index-related exchanged traded products. Mr. Lukof graduated from Bucknell University, Cum Laude, with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. He is active at his alma mater, serving on the Business Analytics Advisory Board.

Before joining Toro Trading in 2009, Mr. Skordal was a specialist on the American Stock Exchange for Susquehanna International Group. He has a fourteen-year working relationship with Mr. Lukof. Mr. Skordal graduated from Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) with a Bachelor of Science (SB) degree in Physics. He is involved with several charities, including Mercy Corps and City at Peace in New York, NY.
