Fund performance is linked with prior Representative Performance which is calculated as a carve-out of gross returns on the portfolio of legal cases financed via the Lending Platform since inception on 11 March 2021 in Pi Fund Limited which is an open-ended investment fund that is registered, regulated, and audited in the Cayman Islands. The current portfolio of legal cases has an average age and case-type concentration greater than expected as the portfolio grows over time, and the majority of cases have not reached final conclusion yet. Figures are adjusted to account for Accumulation investor terms, including administration expenses and investment manager fees as set out in this document, but not including any Initial Fee, and assuming no distributions. Figures for currency-hedged investors have been prepared using historical one-month forward rates and assuming a cost of hedging of 0.5% per annum. Performance over time is expected to fluctuate depending on the mix of ages of legal cases, as each underlying loan pays simple not compound interest. The track record reflects the investor terms which have been designed to ensure that early net performance is consistent with the expected net return over the medium term, assuming a portfolio of 20% shorter-term cases that will take nine months on average and 80% longer-term cases that will take 36 months on average.

Perspective Secured Legal Loans - Overview

The Perspective Secured Legal Loans applies a Strategy by which it provides loans as to give consumers "access to justice" to cover the disbursement expenses of legal claims that they would otherwise be less able to pursue due to the financial commitment required. In the UK, the Jackson Reforms came into force on 1 April 2013, enabling lawyers to enter into conditional fee agreements, firmly supporting third-party funding.

- Current claim types are Housing Disrepair, Military Deafness, Mortgage Interest Miscalculation, and Undisclosed Commissions. Examples of claim types being considered are Bank Fraud, Business Energy, Motor Finance, and Tenancy Deposit.
- Legal disbursements on such claims are typically up to £35,000 with an average of about £10,000.
- Arrangements are made between the consumer, a law firm, an insurer, and the lender such that consumer financial downside is limited, and funder downside is protected too.
- Law firms review potential consumer cases to determine whether they merit being funded and pursued.
- An insurer underwrites the legal case and issues After-The-Event (ATE) policy cover such that if the claim
 fails then both the legal disbursement expenses and interest on the lending to fund these expenses will
 be paid by the insurer.
- An ATE insurer Deed of Indemnity provides additional assurance that the insurer will pay policy claims irrespective of claim circumstances.
- The ATE insurer is credit rated A- (Excellent) currently and has reinsurance cover that is issued by reinsurers that are credit rated A- (Excellent) currently.
- Diversification, to be developed over time, is intended to be across both claim types and law firms, and in due course additional insurers.

Perspective Secured Legal Loans - Investment Differentiators

- **Alignment** The Founder, Directors and Executives represent over 20% of Firm assets under management and have a significant investment in the Secured Legal Loans Strategy.
- **Illiquidity Premium** Investment in less liquid opportunities can provide an increase in expected returns relative to liquid public bonds listed on financial markets.
- **Risk Mitigation** Insurance and reinsurance protection aim to mitigate capital and interest repayment risks.
- **Diversification** Beyond diversification within the strategy itself, performance is likely to be less correlated with conventional investments that are subject to the economic cycle or financial markets.
- **Service** Significant investors have direct access to our senior staff.



Perspective Investments

Perspective Investments is the trading name of Pi Investment Management Limited. It was established in 2008 to manage the founder family wealth, and to provide a structure to enable others to invest alongside. The directors and executives have institutional investment backgrounds and most invest with the Firm, representing a significant amount of the assets under management. External investors include senior executives at financial institutions such as a global investment manager, a specialist insurer, and a sovereign wealth fund.

Perspective performance has benefited from access to specialist investment opportunities that are less liquid and longer-term investments (three to five years). Where the capacity of these investments is sufficient, the Firm has begun to develop products to provide direct access.

Investor Key Terms

An Initial Fee may be chargeable in certain circumstances, and Advisory Fee may be chargeable in certain circumstances.

Accumulation investors: 1.5% Management Fees, capped during the Ramp-Up Period of 36 months such that the total of Management Fee and Fund Administration Expenses are not more than 2.0% per annum, and 10% Performance Fee where performance fee is subject to maintenance of net performance at 6% or more over the most recent 12-month period; Three-year Withdrawal Notice and 95-day payment period, except that Withdrawal Notice is 12 months only until the end of 2027.

Distribution investors: Terms as for Accumulation investors except as follows: 2% Management Fee, capped during the Ramp-Up Period of 36 months such that the total of Management Fee and Fund Administration Expenses are not more than 2.5% per annum; 0.5% Liquidity Management Charge (payable to Accumulation investors); and there will be semi-annual distribution of net income.

Founder Fee arrangements are in place initially to compensate the seed investor for the costs of establishment of the strategy and for the provision of liquidity during the Ramp-Up Period, to ensure that seed investor privileges accrue to the seed investor, and, importantly, to enable rebates to be paid to new investors to ensure that their returns are consistent with the expected return over the medium term until either £20 million of assets from new investors or the end of 2026.

Investment is subject to capacity availability, so subscription commitments may have to be received in tranches as capacity becomes available.

Liquidity: Investment is for the long term. Liquidity will be provided monthly, subject to the notice requirement of three years (except that the requirement is 12 months only until the end of 2027) and 95-day payment period, and with disinvestment payments being made from claims settlement proceeds rather than these claims settlement proceeds being reinvested in new claims. Accordingly, investors should only consider this Strategy if they are prepared to wait to get their money back.

Early withdrawals may be available on request but are not guaranteed to be available and additional charges of 0.5% per month of acceleration would be incurred.

Strategy Administration Expenses are expected to run at c1.2% per annum initially, but this figure is expected to decrease significantly as the Strategy grows.



Valuation, Investments, and Withdrawals

Valuation Day is the last business day of each month.

Investments may be made monthly. Minimum initial Investment is 100,000 EUR or equivalent.

Minimum subsequent investment or withdrawal is 10,000 EUR or equivalent; and minimum withdrawal is 10,000 EUR or equivalent, subject to minimum holding of 100,000 EUR or equivalent.

Withdrawals are processed monthly, subject to notice requirements, standard terms, and any restrictions. Accordingly, investors should only consider this Strategy if they are prepared to wait to get their money back.

Investor Reporting

Fund Factsheets and Valuation Statements are issued monthly and Investment Reports are issued quarterly.

The Pi Secured Legal Loans Fund Limited (the "Fund") is a Sub-Fund of Pi Investments Funds SA SICAV RAIF ("PIFSR"), incorporated and registered in Luxembourg with company number B288551, and with registered office at 12C, rue Guillaume J. Kroll, L-1882 Luxembourg, and registered with the Luxembourg Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier ("CSSF") with registration number V00011015.

PIFSR is a public company limited by shares (société anonyme) incorporated under the laws of Luxembourg, organised as an investment company with variable share capital (société d'investissement à capital variable ("SICAV")) and qualifying as a reserved alternative investment fund (Fonds d'Investissement Alternatif Réservé ("RAIF")).



PIFSR and Fund regulatory compliance is the responsibility of the Alternative Investment Fund Manager ("AIFM") Gamma Capital Markets Limited ("Gamma"). Gamma is incorporated and registered in Malta with company registration number C51103, and with registered office at 259, St. Paul Street Valletta VLT 1213, Malta, and is regulated by the Malta Financial Services Authority ("MFSA") under the Alternative Investment Funds Managers Directive ("AIFMD") and Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities ("UCITS") Management Company regimes with Authorisation ID GMMA, and is authorised to operate within EU under the freedom of services and establishment regimes as well.

The Fund investment management is delegated by the Fund and Gamma via a Sub-Investment Management Agreement to Pi Investment Management Limited (also referred to as "Perspective Investments") which is incorporated and registered in the Cayman Islands with company number 215841, and registered office at Suite 3-301 Governors Square, 23 Lime Tree Bay Avenue, PO Box 11820, Grand Cayman, KY1-1009, Cayman Islands, and is registered with and regulated by the Cayman Islands Monetary Authority ("CIMA") with Firm Reference Number 1628314 and is registered with the UK Financial Conduct Authority with Firm Reference Number 918758.

The Fund, under AIFMD, is classified as an Alternative Investment Fund ("AIF") with Gamma as AIFM being the product "Manufacturer" and "Distributor", and Perspective appointed as Sub Investment Manager.

The Fund is registered with the UK FCA for marketing in the UK via the National Private Placement Regime (NPPR) with Product Reference Numbers (PRNs) 1023483 (for PIFSR) and 1023484 (for the Fund), with the AIFM being Gamma which is registered with the UK FCA with Firm Reference Number 1023455.
